## Travelers for Truth Scripture Song




Color the six sections of the circle: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple. Cut out the circle. Poke a small hole in the center. Pull 18 inches of string through the hole. Grab on to each end of the string. Swing the string in a circle until the entire string is twisted. Then pull the two ends apart and watch the circle spin. Look to see what color is made when all the colors spin together.


- Cut a square piece of paper or use 6"x6" origami paper. Fold your paper in half to form a triangle. Use our Lesson 2 Origami Fish pdf as a template to show where to cut the lines on your fish.
- Open up the triangle and fold the strips to the middle fold (see video). Glue or use double sided tape to attach the strips in the middle. Fold the tail in and cut out a small triangle. Glue on a triangular fish face, heart shaped mouth, and googly eye.

## SHEAF OF GRA/N <br> LESSON10

Use a hole punch to make a hole at both ends of each grain. Get a yellow or $\tan (3 / 8 \mathrm{in}$ wide) ribbon and cut it 1.5 ft long. Use scotch tape to wrap around one end to create a side that can be threaded easily. (You may want to do this for the kids ahead of time). Thread the first hole and make sure the opposite end of the ribbon is taped on the back of the Sheaf of Grain card. Continue threading the ribbon through all the holes. Thread the end back through one of the holes so it is on the back of the card when you finish.



Print these pictures in color or balck and white on cardstock. Cut them out and place in the bottle with rice so the kids can find Jesus in the temple.


## BLIND BARTIMAEUS



Give each child a copy of Blind Bartimaeus' happy and sad faces. Have them cut out the faces. Glue a pencil or stick in between the two masks and stick the happy and sad faces together with glue or tape. You may need to trim around the beard to make it match perfectly.

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Cut out a small Jesus for each child to put in their kaleidoscope.

Print one set of the four prayer cards for each child's Prayer Box.

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## SIISE THE CROOSS

To begin, give each child a cross key ring. Have tables set up around the room with items (see below) that appeal to the kids' senses. At each stop, they will use their senses and get a colored ribbon to tie on the cross. The ribbons will remind the children of what Jesus endured for them.

Station 1: Smell:Flowers, Plants, Olive Oil (Discuss what Jesus would've smelled while He prayed in the garden.) Give the kids a green ribbon for plants and olive trees.
Station 2: Touch: Thorns (Carefully have the children feel a small thorn. Talk about how it would've felt to have a crown of thorns pressed into your head.) Give the children a brown ribbon.
Station 3: Sight: Nails (Show the children a railroad spike. Explain that the nail would've needed to be strong enough to hold a person's body on a cross.) Cive the children a silver ribbon.
Station 4: Sound: Have the kids use hammers to hit nails into a piece of wood. Listen to a hammer pounding a nail into a piece of wood. (Discuss how the soldiers might have felt as they had to nail Jesus to the cross.) Give the children a black ribbon.
Station 5: Taste: Vinegar \& Grape Juice (Have the kids smell the vinegar and grape juice together first. Then, they might only want to drink the grape juice, not the vinegar. Discuss how they mixed together a sour wine for Jesus to drink, but He refused it. The wine might've tasted similar to a mixture of vinegar and grape juice.) Give the kids a purple ribbon.
Station 6: Touch: Water \& Ketchup (Discuss how the blood and water flowed from Jesus' side after the soldier pierced Him with a spear.) Give the kids a red and blue ribbon.
Station 7: Sight \& Sound: Turn off all the lights and make total darkness. Listen to realistic earthquake sounds. https://www.youtube.com/watch? $v=m g L B m L o L 2 A w$. (Discuss how God was there with Jesus on the cross. After Jesus died, there was an earthquake and total darkness, but God's presence was there.) Give the kids a $\qquad$ to represent the presence of God.

Now the kids have a colorful ribbon bookmark to use in their Bibles.
