- ❑ **Bleach** (Two quart or one 82 oz. bottle)
- ❑ **Scouring pads** (5)
- ❑ **Sponges** (7 pack, assorted sizes)
- ❑ **Scrub brush** (1)
- ❑ **Reusable wipes or cleaning cloths** (8)
- ❑ **Liquid laundry detergent** (Two 25 oz or one 50 oz bottle)
- ❑ **Household cleaner** (One 12 - 16 oz bottle)
- ❑ **Disinfectant Dish Soap** (One 16-28 oz bottle)
- ❑ **Clothes pins** (50)
- ❑ **Clothes line** (Two 50 ft or one 100 ft)
- ❑ **Dust Masks** (5)
- ❑ **Latex or non-latex gloves** (2 pair)
- ❑ **Work gloves** (1 pair)
- ❑ **Heavy duty trash bags** (24 count of 33- 45 gallon bags. Please remove before placing in bucket)
- ❑ **Insect repellent spray** (One 6-14 oz can. Aerosol cans must have protective caps)
- ❑ **Air freshener** (One 8 or 9 oz can. Aerosol cans must have protective caps)

- ☐ Toy Vehicle(s) (Emergency vehicles - Police, Fire, Ambulances - so children can express their feelings in play)
- ☐ Soft, Cuddly "Plush" or Stuffed Toy

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- ☐ Doll or Community Worker Action Figures
- ☐ Fidget Toy
- ☐ Blanket
- ☐ Stickers
- ☐ Small flashlight
- ☐ Card Game
- ☐ Reusable drawing tablet or dry erase board



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
